Re: ADTU Scholarships and Bursaries

Each year the ADTU awards five scholarships worth \$700 each and three bursaries worth \$500 each (One Bursary is designated for an Alternate Programs Student).

2018 Graduating students should ensure that scholarship/bursary applications and supporting documents are submitted to the ADTU by 3:00 p.m. Wednesday, April 18. For ADSS students, the application process is through the ADSS Counselling Department. The application process for Alternate Program Students will be determined later.

The criteria for awarding Scholarships and Bursaries is as follows:

- a) Monies be awarded to students attending accredited post-secondary normally be used during the academic year following high school graduation.
- b) Preference is given to the sons and daughters of members of the Alberni District Teachers' Union, or to the sons and daughters of retired members of the Alberni District Teachers' Union.
- c) Applicants must be enrolled in a Public School
- d) High marks and academic excellence be considered.
- e) The financial needs of the applicants are considered.
- f) Scholarships and Bursaries may not be awarded to students who are receiving full Tuition and living expenses scholarship from a post-secondary institution.
