ADTU SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES POLICY

ADTU Scholarships & Bursaries

- 1. That the President of the A.D.T.U. appoint the Scholarship, Bursary and Awards Committee annually by January, for that year: and, it is recommended that the Committee include the following:
 - a) a member from Ucluelet Secondary
 - b) a member from Alberni District Secondary
 - c) a member from District Alternate Programs
 - d) not less than three (3) other members-at-large
- 2. That the Scholarship, Bursary and Awards Committee be solely responsible for making all final award decisions.
- 3. That the following guidelines be used (in order of priority):
 - a) that the monies be awarded to students attending accredited post-secondary normally be used during the academic year following high school graduation.
 - b) that the preference be given to the children of members of the Alberni District Teachers' Union, or to the children of retired members of the Alberni District Teachers' Union.
 - c) that applicants must be enrolled in a Public School.
 - d) that high marks and academic excellence be considered.
 - e) that the financial needs of the applicants be considered.
 - f) Scholarships and Bursaries may not be awarded to students who are receiving full tuition and living expenses scholarship from a post-secondary institution.
