

SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARY POLICY

ADTU Scholarships & Bursaries

- 1. That the President of the A.D.T.U. appoint the Scholarship, Bursary and Awards Committee annually by January, for that year: and, it is recommended that the Committee include the following:
 - a) a member from Ucluelet Secondary
 - b) a member from Alberni District Secondary
 - c) a member from District Alternate Programs
 - d) not less than three (3) other members-at-large
- 2. That the Scholarship, bursary and Awards Committee be solely responsible for making all final award decisions.
- 3. That the following guidelines be used (in order of priority):
 - a) that the monies be awarded to students attending accredited post-secondary normally be used during the academic year following high school graduation.
 - b) that the preference be given to the sons and daughters of members of the Alberni District Teachers' Union, or to the sons and daughters of retired members of
 the Alberni District Teachers' Union
 - the Alberni District Teachers' Union.
 - c) that applicants must be enrolled in a Public School
 - d) that high marks and academic excellence be considered.
 - e) that the financial needs of the applicants be considered.
 - f) Scholarships and Bursaries may not be awarded to students who are receiving full tuition and living expenses scholarship from a post-secondary institution.
